








Comparative Local Income (FY 2019 - 2021)










Status of our Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) (FY 2019 - 2021)










Real Property Tax (RPT) Collection (FY 2019 - 2021)










Business Permit & Licensing (BPL) Collection (FY 2019 - 2021)










INCIDENCE OF CRIMES Comparative January to April 2020 & 2021
